



CHATEAU MYON DE L'ENCLOS 2008



Winery

Château Myon de l'Enclos is located in Moulis en Medoc. Created in 1985, the winery now is composed of 5 hectares to which are added the 17 hectares of Château Mayne Lalande in the appellation Lustrac-Médoc. Alice-Jeanne takes over its management in December 2020.

Vineyard

Cepages : cabernet sauvignon (50%), merlot (50%)

Soils : well draining clay-limestone, gravel and stones usually called « gravel, clay and limestone terroirs »

Planting densities : 6500 to 9000 plots per hectare

HVE 3 Certified vineyard

Winemaking

Manual and mechanical harvesting, parcelled selections

Maceration and cooling to approx. 8°C between 10 and 12 days

Traditional vinification – Aging : 14 months in barrels (40% new – french oak)

Yield : 37.5 HL / HA – Production : 25 000 bottles

Assemblage : 50 % cabernet sauvignon, 50% merlot

Tasting comments

The dynamic Bernard Lartigue (Mayne Lalande in Lustrac) has 5 ha in Moulis on a clay-limestone and silico-gravel soil. Merlot and Cabernet-Sauvignon make equal play here to give a wine of a beautiful purple color with ruby reflections. The aromas of blackcurrant and blackberry, mixed with woody and toasted notes, increase in complexity to the palate to give a set as elegant as well balanced.
